INFORMATION FOR THE TEAM MANAGERS

1. Official communiqués

- To limit the use of paper, the official communiqués for the teams will be sent by email; printed copy will be provided only on request at the Permanence.

2. Training

- Regular training is recommended according to the local traffic rules; Handbike Athletes **must** put a flag on their handbike.

- To reduce the impact on local activities, official training is not scheduled

3. Time Trial

- Race course will be closed (vehicles and cyclists) 30' before the start; after this time, traffic on the course is forbidden

- Teams that want to assist Athletes at the finish line must reach the parking area before the race start or by Oberalstrasse (L109) coming form Schonach

- Specific time spots in between morning/afternoon sessions are scheduled to let teams/Athletes come back to the start line

- A specific lane will be provided on the course to let Athletes come back from the finish line in small groups to the start line while the race is running. A Commissaire will manage the departure.

Please remind that this lane is **OUT** of the race and Athletes must use it a **low speed!!!**

- Technical assistance: 4 fixed points will be available on the course; Teams are allowed to provide their own technical assistance along the course (staff member must wear team suit)
- Due to lack of internet access on the finish lines, TT results and other communicates will be dispatched as soon as possible during the day

4. Road Races

- Race course will be closed (vehicles) 30' before the start; after this time, traffic on the course is forbidden.

- Bike check and call up area is located in Baerenplatz (50mt before start - fountain)

- The feed/waste zone is located on Nikolausstrasse and will be marked with signs.

- Teams are allowed to provide their own technical assistance along the course (staff member must wear team suit)

- Race departures will be given without neutral start

- At the start of C1-C2-C3 races, to prevent possible accidents, rider holders can't wear/hold any item (backpack, wheels, cameras, etc)

- MH3-4-5 races will be on 7 laps (51 kms) instead of 8 laps

5. Team Relay

- Tests will be conducted at Minigolf in Schonach (the town next after the long TT course finish line)

- Organisation will provide a van + a wheelchair for Athletes who need assistance • Road Races

- Tests will be conducted at FestHalle in Elzach, as indicated on the official bullettin - For specific and more accurate instructions please look at the information provided by the Doping Control Officer.

7. Protocol

- We remind that the Protocol Ceremony is a <u>relevant part</u> of the event, so please Team Managers are strongly required to pay attention to take the Athletes to the Ceremony <u>on time</u>.
