

INFORMATION FOR THE TEAM MANAGERS

Team Reminders:

Training

- Please remind your riders to follow traffic rules during training with open traffic. On roads with multiple lanes in the same direction, it is forbidden to ride against the direction of traffic. It is for your own safety that we ask you to use safety lights on your bikes and handcycles.
- Handbike Athletes **must** have a flag on their hand bike when on open roads. Flags are available at the hotels.
- During breaks in the competition, the course remains closed in order for the organization to supply volunteers. No training is allowed and riders must respect all traffic rules.

Time Trial

- Training on the course closes 15 minutes before the first start of the day and all riders must exit the course as quickly as possible.
- All classes of riders are allowed on the course during warmup. Please use extra caution when classes with different cycles, tricycles and equipment are on the course.
- Bike check will be conducted at the start area before the time trials. Bike check is reserved for starting riders only, 15 minutes before the first start time.
- Following cars exiting the Athletes' Village are crossing the active race course. Please follow the directions of the marshals and use extreme caution driving to staging on Explorer Blvd.
- Radios may be collected at team car staging. Radios may be returned when a team is done following their riders at the crossing point to return to the Athletes' Village.
- Riders are responsible for knowing their time trial distance and laps. Riders must exit the course immediately after their finish by turning right on Moquin.
- Follow cars must take the deviation (right turn) at Farrow Rd, located at last traffic light before the finish line. Proceed to the PPO. The PPO will deliver follow cars to meet their athletes on Moquin. Teams may park at Columbia High School.

Road Races

- Riders may reach the staging area from the Athletes' Village by turning west on Explorer Blvd, on the opposite side of the road of the race course. Please proceed to the crossover point 150 m behind the finish line.
- Riders may not enter the starting grid for call-ups from beyond the finish line. Riders approaching their call-up against the flow of the race will be sent around to the staging area and will be placed last in the grid.
- Riders not in the staging area for call-ups will be placed at the back of the grid.
- Hand cycle and tricycle riders are asked to assemble in a herringbone pattern against the fences to allow riders to move into position.
- For the safety of the riders at the start, holders in the C1, C2 and C3 races may not hold equipment, umbrellas or wear backpacks.

Team Relay

- Participating Teams must present their Team Relay start list to the Race Secretary at the finish line Sunday, September 6 within 1 hour of the finish of the last event of the day.
- The Team Relay Managers' meeting will be conducted at 13:00 at the Start/Finish line on Monday, September 7.

Protocol

A reminder that the Protocol/Awards Ceremonies are a critical part of the event. Team Managers are requested to deliver their riders at the appropriate times for their awards ceremony.

Wishing all teams and riders the greatest success in their efforts, I am at your disposal to provide information and resolve, to the best of my ability, any issues that might affect the smooth running of the competition.
