

Materiel Reminder to all riders:

Socks and overshoes used in competition may not rise above the height defined by half the distance between the middle of the lateral malleolus (ankle) and the middle of the fibula head (knee joint) be higher than the midpoint between the ankle and

Riders with leg adaptations / braces may only be covered to this same defined point.

Timing Transponders return :

Please don't forget to return all your transponders at the finish line immediately after the last race of your riders. Please be quick as it gets dark rapidly after the last race tonight.

Team Relay Reminders

- The Team Relay Managers' meeting will be conducted at 13:00 at the Start/Finish line on Monday, September 7. Please report to the rear of the Judges Platform. The first 5 teams of the last World Championships are entitled to draw their exchange corridor location. The remaining teams will have their exchange position drawn by lot.
- A diagram of the relay has been provided below.
- The course will run the reverse direction of the road races.
- The exchange zone is located approximately 150 m from the finish line. The first riders will be staged at the Start/Finish and proceed past the relay zone and complete a full lap, before the first exchange.
- The course will narrow slightly approaching the exchange zone to create a starting zone for the team relays.
- On the first lap, riders must stay to the left around the first U turn at Farrow Rd. and past the crossing point. Riders finishing each lap will stay left after passing the line for their team relay and remain left around the corner up to the crossing zone.
- Relay riders will start and remain on the right side of the cones demarking the course
- Riders will be held at the crossing point until it is safe to cross the road and rejoin their team corridor.
- Only two support staff are allowed in each team relay area.
