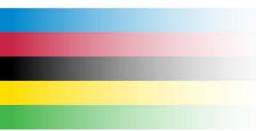

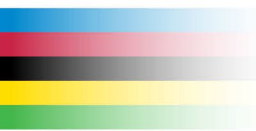

Feeding at any time of the road races or time trials

Neutral Service will have bottles available

Hot weather protocol group met earlier today

Reduction of race distances for Road Races

- Men's C4/5 Road Race – removal of 1 lap from all races – 6 laps total now
- Men's B and Women's B Road Race – removal of 1 lap from all races – 7 laps men, 6 laps women now
- Handcycle team relay will now start at 18:30 on Monday 7 September

Team Managers' Meeting

- ✓ Doping controls will be conducted under the 2023 Anti-Doping Rules of the UCI and the International Testing Agency (ITA) procedures and instructions
- ✓ Location of the Doping Control Station (DCS) is signposted
- ✓ **Lists of selected athletes are no longer displayed**
- ✓ **Riders will be notified by chaperones**; the notified rider shall remain within sight of the chaperone at all times from the moment of in-person notification until the completion of the sample collection procedure. Team officials should not prevent the chaperone to continuously observe the rider
- ✓ Riders must report ASAP and at the latest within 30 min of finishing the race or within 30 min of the end of the ceremony or press conference if applicable

Team Managers' Meeting

- ✓ It is recommended that athletes present themselves at the DCS alone. But at most they may be accompanied by only one person
- ✓ Representative must accompany minor athletes (-18 years old)
- ✓ Must bring identification document (with photo) – licence, ID card, passport
- ✓ No shower or toilet before the doping control
- ✓ Wearing a mask in the DCS is recommended for athletes and accompanying person
- ✓ Any changes related to accommodation must be reported ASAP through **ITA Rooming App**
- ✓ Nations should ask their hotel not to prevent entrance to DCOs

COURSE MAP - TT

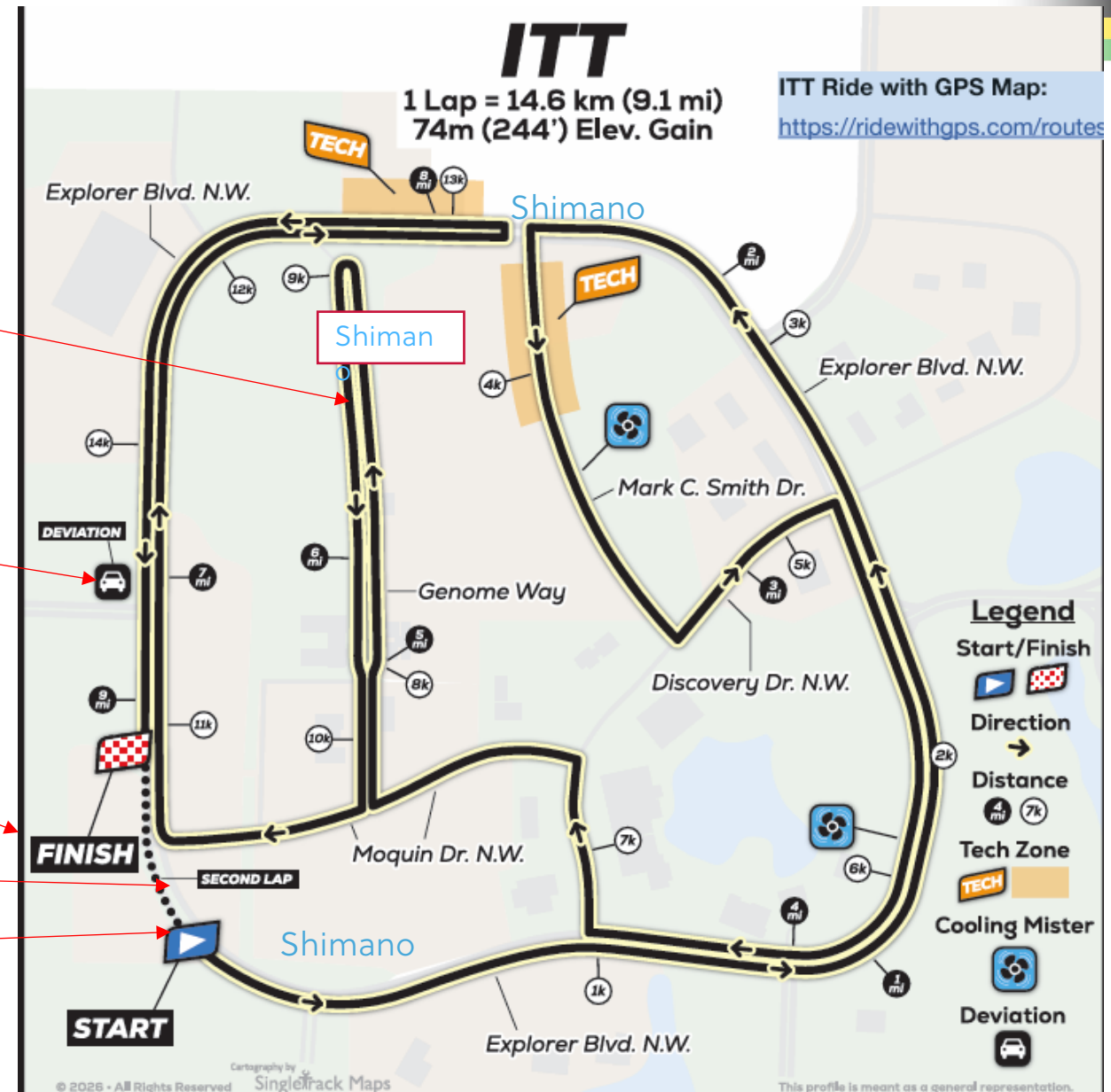

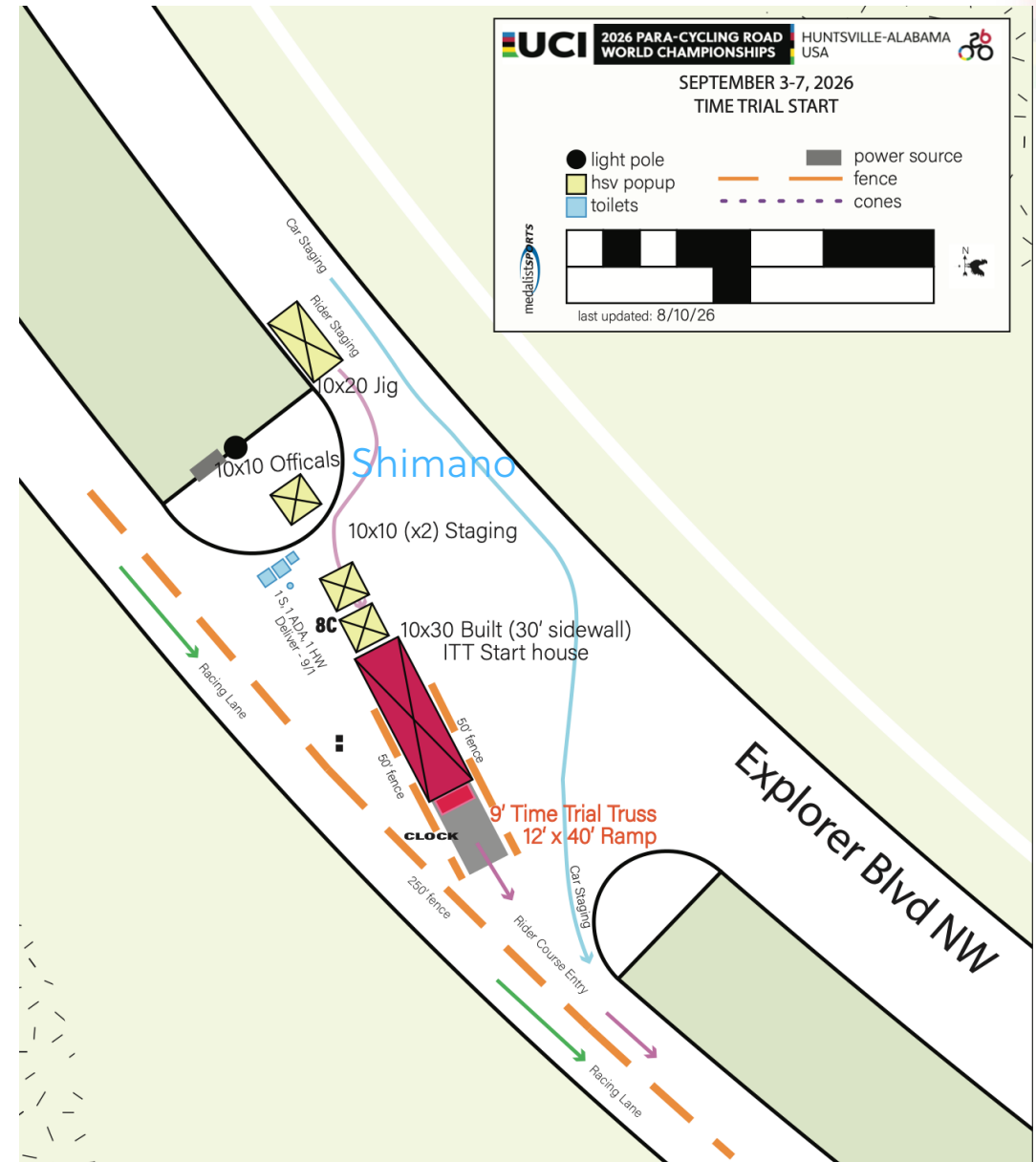
RADIO FOR CARS DURING ITT



- Radios will be issued to the driver at the start house staging point. Please present your license, required for each follow car, as noted in the Technical Guide.
- Radios will be collected at the course crossing at the return to the athlete village.

TT START AREA

- All riders must enter the TT start area through the bike check .
- Shimano will be located at the same point for mechanical assistance.
- Team follow cars will be staged to follow their rider.
- Riders may warm up on the opposite side of the Explorer Blvd between Moquin and Discovery.



TT – TEAM FOLLOW CAR and DEVIATION

Team follow cars leave the Athletes' Village under the direction of the course marshals and report to the staging coordinator at the bottom of Moquim.

Cars will be directed to the start ramp.

Follow cars will merge behind their rider, watching for following or lapping riders.

Team cars may not enter Genome Drive. Vehicles will be stopped on the left side of Moquim when the rider turns onto Genome Dr. When the rider returns to Moquim, team cars will continue to follow their rider.

Team cars that enter Genome Dr. Will be stopped and will remain parked until the conclusion of their race. (Commissaires may have additional penalties)

Multiple laps (2):

- Team cars may follow their rider through the finish line on the first lap.
- Caution for starting riders

TT – TEAM FOLLOW CAR and DEVIATION

Deviation:

Before the finish of their rider's race, team cars must turn right at the traffic signal before the finish line (Farrow)

Follow the return signs through the PPO.

Vehicles will return to the Athletes' Village or restaged at the bottom of Moquim as directed by course marshals.

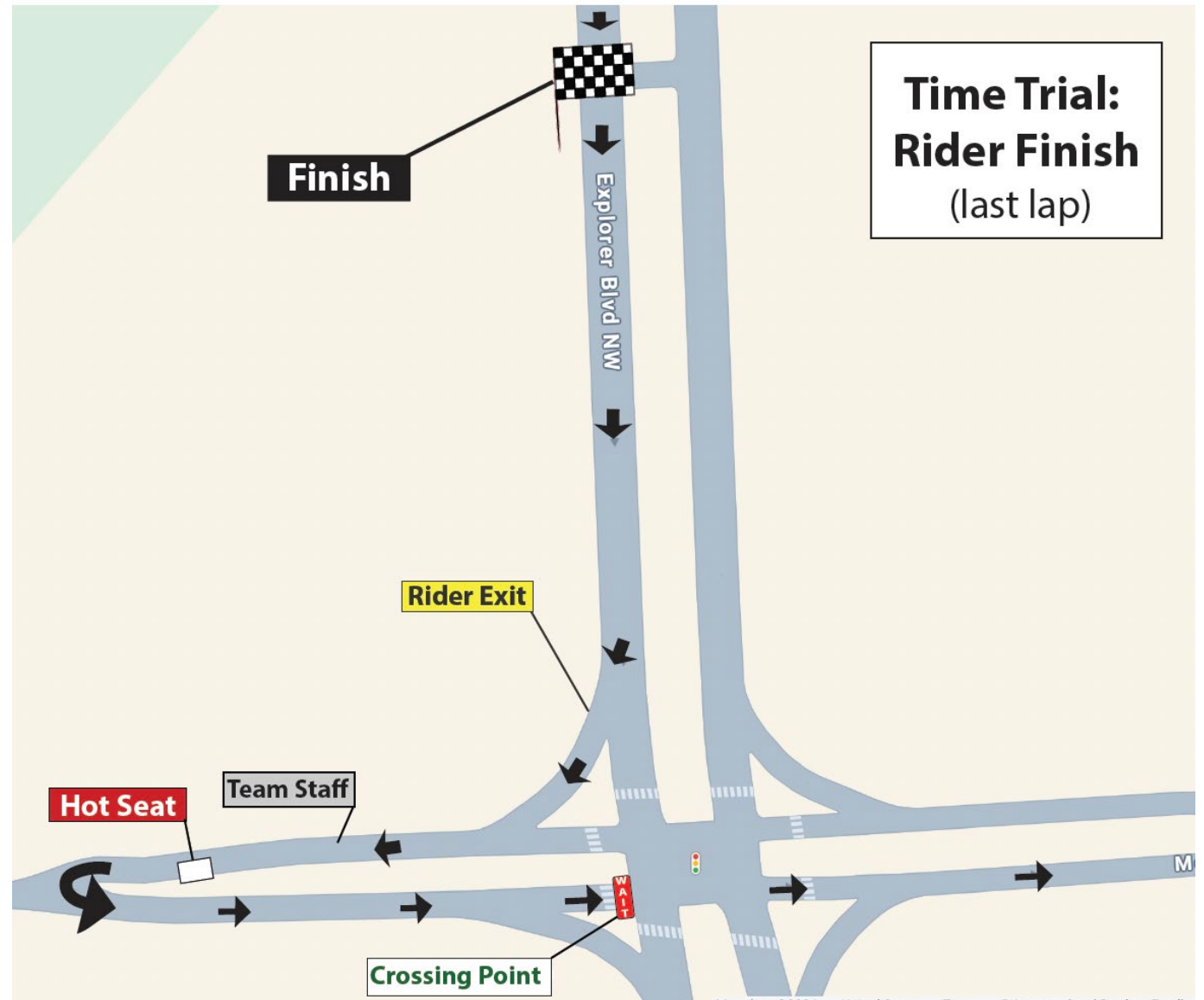


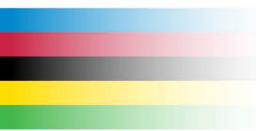
TT - HOT SEAT

- A time trial **hot seat** procedure is in place for all Para cycling Individual Time Trial Races.
- The current race leader in each class is required to wait in the dedicated hot seat area for media purposes until released by UCI staff.
- Cold water, ice and towels will be available.
- The leader shall remain at the hot seat location until a new best finishing time is recorded.
- The winner will return to the athletes' village at the end of the race for their respective class.

RIDER EXIT / TT - HOT SEAT

- Riders must exit the course at the first right turn after the finish of their race.
- Soigneurs and team personnel can meet their riders at the end of Moquin.
- Finished riders and support staff are not allowed on Explorer Blvd NW.





RIDER COOLING



- Rider cooling stations will be in operating during the Time Trial
- Riders may be cooled/sprayed by staff/followers in locations outside the finish zone
- Cooling supplies available near the Hot Seat location for finishing riders



RADIO DISTRIBUTION / RETURN



- Radio tour radios will be distributed at follow car staging
- Radios will be collected at the crossing point after your return through the PPO
 - If you are following another rider, please inform the radio return volunteer

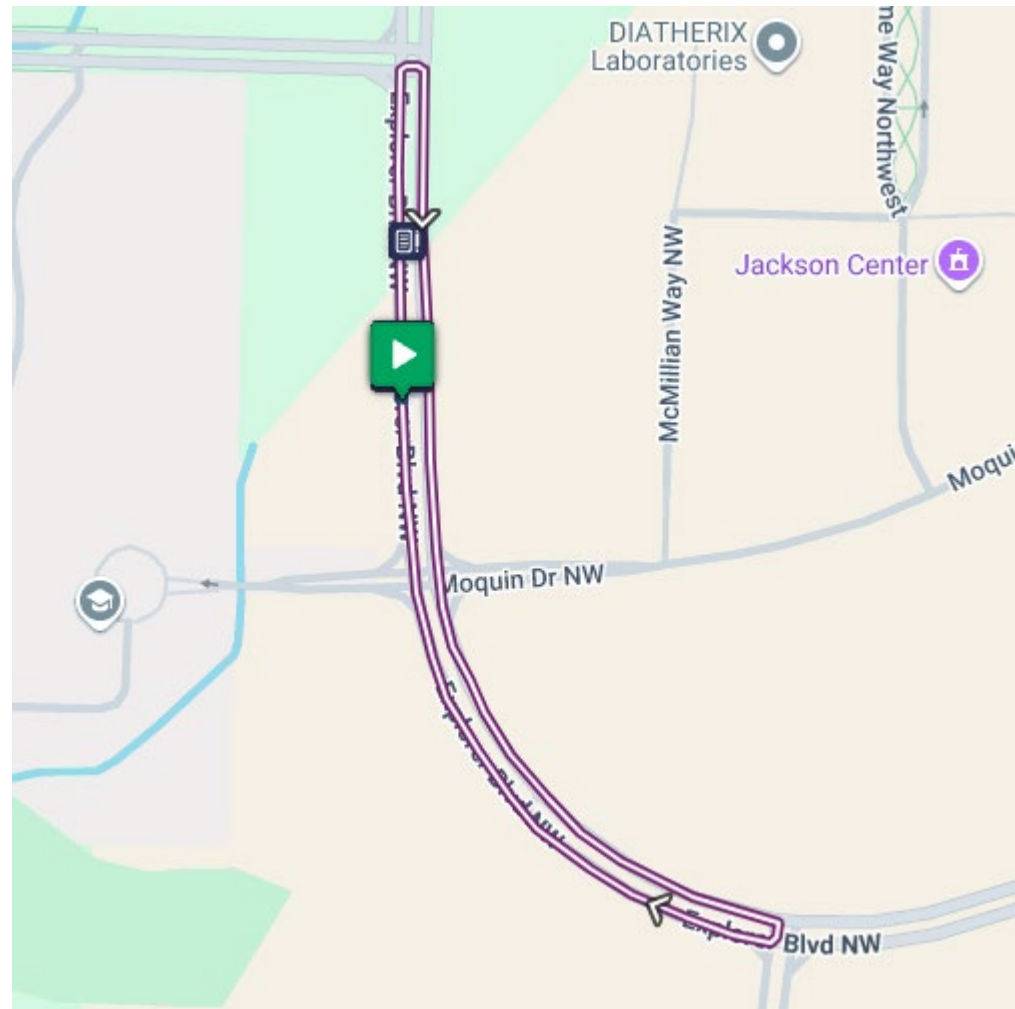
RR COURSE MAP

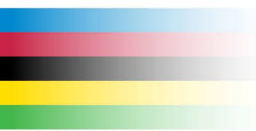

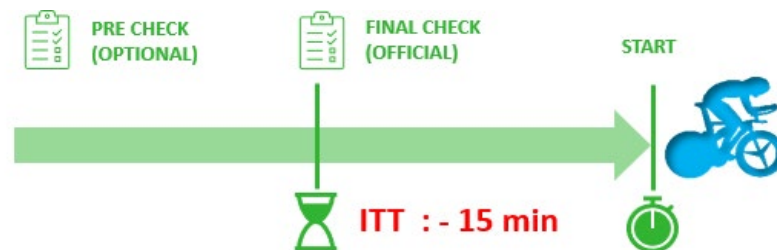
COMMISSAIRE UPDATE



- UCI Rules (Part I, II, XVI) & UCI penalty scale
- Commissaires Communique – please read the information
- Daily Communiques, including start lists
- [training note about flags, safety lights]
- For RR & TT - Safety Bars securely fitted, to both Handbikes and Trikes
- Bike plates, numbers and transponders correctly fitted
- For ITT, Race numbers can be placed in transparent pockets
- For RR Race numbers must be fitted to the outside of the jersey no transparent pockets
- For Handbikes for ITT & RR large number on left hand side – limb or cockpit

COMMISSAIRE UPDATE

- For ITT, Pre-Checks for bike – Friday 11.00 - 12.30 then final checks before the competition at 12.45

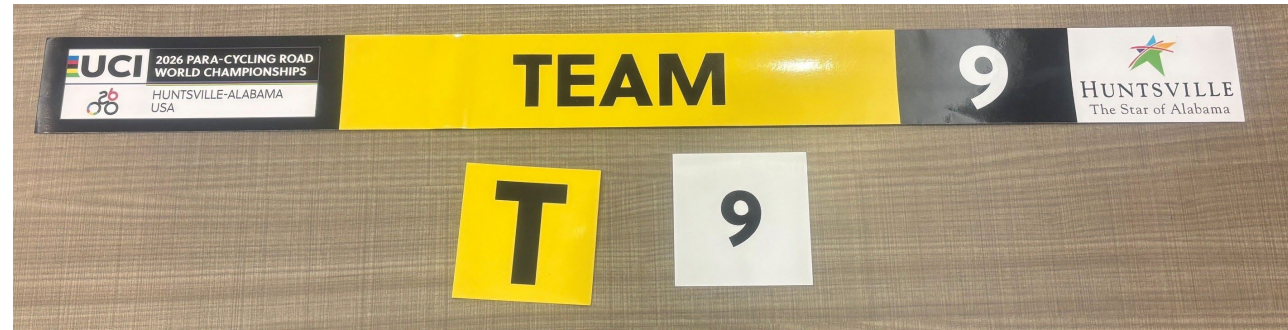


- Saturday Pre-Checks 08.30 - 9.30 then 9.45 start competition checks
- For ITT, race bike checks 15 minutes prior the start – riders must also present at this time dressed as they intend to compete for Personal Equipment Check
- Call Up RR 10 minutes prior to start – riders must be there when their name is called or be placed at back of grid
- Victory Ceremony (Race clothing, race shoes or trainers, NO headbands or sunglasses)
- Following Cars in TT**
- Number of cars as per UCI regulation 16.7.011 - Must observe what is happening around them on the course and not block any riders
- Must have their Cycling License on the Windscreen or Digital

FOLLOWING CARS TT & TEAM VEHICLES

Following Cars

- Car Windscreen Banners and Numbers for Rear Window will be issued after Team Managers Meeting – based on number of vehicles permitted
- Manager to bring UCI Licence for each driver and stickers will be issued



Vehicle Access to Athletes Village

- Following Vehicles with Windscreen Banners do not need a T sticker
- All other vehicles will need a T sticker to access Athletes Village after meeting



COMMISSAIRE UPDATE



National Jerseys

- All must have been pre-checked at rider registration – non-compliant jerseys will be penalised in line with the UCI regulations

Helmet Colours – for Road defined in 16.10.002

- Wrong coloured Helmet – Not allowed to start – withdrawn and Disqualified

Numbers for Tandem

Pilot: Black number

For the athlete: Red or White number

Transponders must be mounted for all Races



RR – GENERAL INFORMATION



For non medalists who are estimated to finish close or beyond the estimated start of the next race, the commissaires may at their discretion move the finish line to 300 metres prior to the official finish line and place riders at this point to ensure operations remain on schedule.

Once the finish line is clear they will be permitted to cross the finish line for photo opportunity.



FEEDING ARRANGEMENTS



There is no restriction on first and last feeding and cooling – this can be done throughout the races including TT.

Riders can feed and cool anywhere on course – please be careful – remember no more than 1m from side of the road. Officials following riders on bikes can cool from the bike as required – but no drafting.

Plastic water bottles will be available in multiple locations on the course – riders can take these and drop them at the side of the road – anywhere on the course.

Riders will be penalised for throwing bottles into fields etc – they must be where they can be picked
