

INFORMATION FOR THE TEAM MANAGERS

1. Official communiqués

- To limit the use of paper, the official communiqués for the teams will be sent by email; printed copy will be provided only on request at the Permanence.

- A dedicate WhatsApp group is also available to receive information and communicates about the event.



2. Training

- It is strongly recommended to follow traffic rules during regular training and circulation with open traffic; Handbike Athletes **must** put a flag on their handbike.

3. Time Trial

- Race course will be closed (vehicles and cyclists) 30' before the start; after this time, traffic on the course is forbidden

- Training on the race course is not allowed after the start of the first rider

- Riders must come to the bike check, located near the start area, 15 minutes before their start.

- Following cars are allowed according to UCI rules

- After the finish line, Athletes must slow down and exit the course on via Tolmezzo (1st road on the left hand side), following the instruction by the volunteers

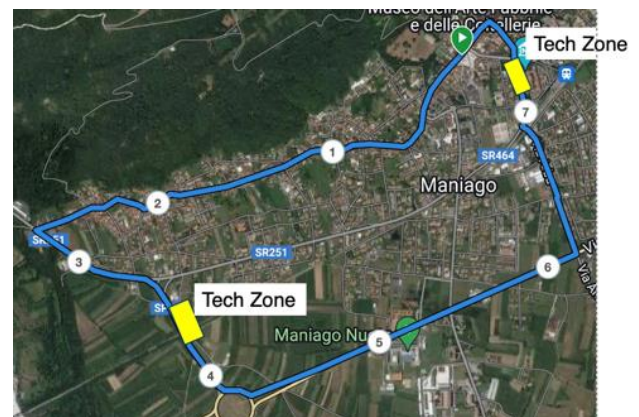

4. Road Races

- Race course will be closed (vehicles) 30' before the start; after this time, traffic on the course is forbidden.
- Training on the race course is not allowed after the start of the first race
- At the call up, Athletes are required to adopt the "Fish-Bone system"
- The Feed zone/green zone/tech zone is located on via Vittorio Emanuele (road aside the Teams Area), marked with signs
- A 2nd Tech Zone is located on via Marco Polo/via Dalmazia
- At the start of C1-C2-C3 races, to prevent possible accidents, rider **holders can't wear/hold** any item (backpack, wheels, etc)



5. Team Relay

- Each participating Team in the Team Relay must present their start list to the Commissaires Secretary **at the Finish Line Commissaires office, Saturday 18 May at 7,00pm at least.**
- Team Relay meeting will be conducted **Sunday 19 May at 1,30pm** at Finish Line

6. Doping Control

- Will be conducted at Boccia Club (TT) and at Classification Building at RR Finish Line; locations are signed with arrows.
- For specific and more accurate instructions please look at the information provided by the Doping Control Officer.

7. Protocol

- We remind that the Protocol Ceremony is a **relevant part** of the event, so please Team Managers are strongly required to pay attention to take the Athletes to the Ceremony **on time**.
