




MEDICAL SUPPORT STRUCTURE

Training/Warm up

- Allowed 1 h before start of morning session + during breaks (not during ceremonies)
- > Each session splitted in 2 parts

1st: M-W C


2nd: M-W B

- Please leave the track when required
- Limiting the number of staff on the safety zone
- Standing starts allowed in the sprinter lane only, on the home straight (1 rider at a time)
- Please communicate between coaches during training sessions to ensure safe training

Commissaires Communiqués – please read!

Numbers correctly fitted

- 1 for timed events
- o 2 for Scratch, Elimination, Sprint and Sprint Qualification

Competition Regulations – Individual Pursuit

- May not repass in Individual Pursuit if caught during qualification, must complete distance for time
- No drafting

Victory Ceremony (Race clothing, race shoes or trainers, NO headbands or sunglasses)



Bike Check

o Bike checked minimum 15 minutes before start

Coaches – only 1 coach trackside for pursuit events

Replacements/Changes for Team Sprint must be notified to Secretary 30 min before the start of the event

Keep walkways and ramps clear during competition at all times

Scratch and Elimination – all riders can have a coach holding at the start at the blue band



Tandem Sprint

- Qualifying over 4.5 laps from the back straight
- Matched sprints will be over 3 laps from the pursuit line

Schedule for punctuality – the programme is very heavy – ensure riders are ready for starts and awards ceremony.

Time trials qualification (Kilo)

- o 2 up for qualification, top 6 for final and start in reverse order
- Riders are allowed only two starts. A restart is only allowed for a false start (jumping out of block) or a recognized mishap. A pulled foot is not a mishap.
- All classes will do qualification regardless of numbers at final qualification



Elimination Race


- The race start will be given when all riders are considered to be riding in a compact bunch
- Any riders about to be lapped before a sprint will be eliminated as though they were the last over the line that time and ranked at that point
- Gaining a lap does not count i.e. the rider is not a lap up
- Neutralization due to fall, puncture, etc..., is 5 laps as per regulation 16.8.039 and 3.2.020 bis.



1.3.033 Socks and overshoes used in competition may not rise above the height defined by half the distance between the middle of the lateral malleolus and the middle of the fibula head.
